DESCRIPTIONS

Chardasia

A blend of Chardonnay and Malvasia. This is arguably the most pleasant marriage of two white grape varieties. The incredibly intense, fruit filled bouquet and flavour of the Malvasia is paired beautifully with the buttery, vanilla and apple like character of the Chardonnay.

Chardonnay

This classic white varietal has creamy oak and vanilla undertones accented with flavours and aromas of fresh green apples and lush tropical fruit.

Chamblaise

Light coloured and easy drinking light bodied wine. This wine is smooth, clean and well balanced with a citrus like acidity. Can be enjoyed fresh, since long aging is not required.

Grignonay

A blend of Pinot Grigio and Chardonnay. The dry crisp and acidic characteristics of Pinot Grigio seem to have been made to blend in perfectly with the buttery, nutty and vanilla tones of the Chardonnay. Ends with a slight oak finish.

Gewurztraminer

Your perfect summer companion – introduced by a unique aroma of cloves, lychee fruit and roses. A natural acidity gives it a soft spicy flavour. Delicious when finished either dry or off dry.

Johannesburg Riesling

Pale and delicately flavoured with slight tartness. Clean taste with flinty lime flavour and spicy bouquet.

Malvasia

A rich and textured yellow gold wine, dry and light to the tongue. It offers lush aromas and flavours of honey and ripe Bosc pears with hints of allspice, leading to a crisp, clean finish.

Muller-Thurgau

This variety was created in the 19th century as a cross between Riesling and Sylvaner. The resulting wines are semi-dry with fragrant aromas and a crisp, clean fruity flavour. A great summer wine.

Palomino

A very aromatic light dry wine with low acid made with palomino sherry grapes from Spain. You'll appreciate the surprising nutty flavour along with essences of apples and spice.

Pinot Grigio

A fabulously balanced crisp white wine with a delicate floral bouquet. Flavours of tropical fruit, peach, apple and a subtle hint of spice and honey will entice your palate.

Riesling

Nice bright yellow with slight green highlights. Crisp, fresh white wine with aromas of apple and apple blossoms with a lime/lemon hint. This wine has a fresh attack, with a lively finish.

Sauvignon Blanc

A refreshing, easy drinking, dry white wine with medium body. On the nose you will find herbaceous, grassy notes, tropical fruit and a hint of smokiness from the toasted oak.

Soave

Italy's most popular dry white wine. It is silky with a soft, pleasant nose and is a versatile wine with delicate aromas of hazelnuts and almonds. Light, crisp and clean, it should be drunk while still young.

Trebbiano

Light amber in colour, with reflections bordering on golden. It has a fruity character with good acidity. Fresh and exuberant, with a good alcohol level. Lively and fresh.

Viognier

Viognier is full-bodied with a texture that is thick and creamy. The flavours begin with exotic fruit like lychee, mango and kiwi and then finish with a light combination of toast, smoke and honey. Its low acid character makes it ideal for sipping.

Zinfandel Blush

Fruity and refreshing with just a hint of rose, offering a refreshing taste with berry overtones like candied raspberries. A medium bodied, easy drinking wine.

Amarone

This big-bodied, deep, red wine is alive with rich characters of very ripe sundried fruit and satiating spice with the rich flavours of raisins, licorice, tobacco and dried fig lingering on the palate. This higher alcohol wine needs time in the bottle to mature and develop into a velvety wine of distinct flavour and character.

Barolo

A rich and robust Italian wine with an intense bouquet of ripe berries and generous black fruit flavours complemented with firm tannins.

Bergamais

Crisp and refreshing, a succulent, medium dark wine tasting of cherries and jammy fruits. Can be enjoyed while young but is also good when aged.

Cabernet Franc

This youthful buoyant red is light and tasty with a pronounced varietal character. A light and grassy flavour made up of sweet cassis fruit, green pepper, black currant, strawberry and chocolate.

Caberlot

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. A well-known blend of rich classic dry Cabernet, and fruity Merlot. Warm, full bodied and intense, this wine has a berry bouquet and full oaky characteristics. The lush, soft character of Merlot is the perfect foil for Cabernet's intensity, resulting in a smooth red wine.

Cabernet Sauvignon

This flavoursome wine is deep ruby in colour and has bold fruit flavours of blackberry, black currants, plums with a dash of spice. Although dry to the taste the red berry and cedar aromas help make this a full bodied wine.

Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz

Cabernet and Shiraz are both forces to be reckoned with. The Shiraz helps in adding even more substance to a slightly lighter Cabernet. Also, Shiraz will add some spice of black peppercorns in order to balance the lighter fruit flavours of the Cabernet.

Castel Del Papa

Ruby in colour with flashes of ripe black raspberry purple, you will surely be charmed by its ripe fruit, lavender and spice aromas. Moreover, its medium level acidity supports a firm tannic structure and its high level of augments its distinguished fullness of flavour.

Chianti

A blend that is dominated by Sangiovese. It is a young ruby colour tending to garnet and shows aromas of black cherries and chocolate with aromatic spices and wood. With good acidity and well-integrated tannins, that tuck is firm and it has both richness and finesse in the mouth. A pleasing, aromatic wine.

Lambrusca

This wine is ruby in colour with aromas of strawberries and cherries. It has a clean, smooth attack with good length and structure and is a pleasant easy drinking red wine. Its red berry flavours are very enjoyable and it finishes strongly with attractive freshness.

Merlot

A fabulously smooth and easy to drink dry red wine with low tannins. Rich in colour, this merlot is filled with flavours of blackberry, black currant and plums. Finishes with a velvety texture.

Montepulciano

Deep ruby robe with violet reflections. Distinct aromas of raspberry with a hint of herbs. A full-bodied wine suited for ageing yet surprising pleasant and smooth when young. Fruity and well structured.

Nero D'Avola

Native to Sicily, capable of producing wines of great distinction with complexity, richness and texture that are capable of ageing for many years. The predominant bouquet is of ripe black cherries with a hint of underbrush and an ever so slight ripe banana nuance and oaked.

Petite Syrah

This grape variety produces a wine that is deep in colour, robust and well structured. Very peppery with rich tannins, it is a wine with potential for cellaring and is ideal for the wine lover who is looking for a big, bold, full-bodied red.

Pinomer

Blend of Pinot Noir and Merlot. Combining these two relatively soft, delicate reds has resulted in a wine that is full-bodied and incredibly smooth. The intense red berry flavour is enhanced by the spicy character of the Merlot, creating a truly unique experience.

Pinot Noir

A rich, dark red wine, surprisingly smooth. Very fruity with spicy undertones and a full bouquet reminiscent of black currant. Gentle oak aging adds complexity. Ages delightfully.

Sangiovese

A rich, dry wine, showing burgundy red in the glass – balanced and crisp. Its aroma whispers of cherry and raspberry, spiced with vanilla and cinnamon, as well as coffee, leather, plums and bay leaves. The finish is clean and pleasant, yet slightly sweet and a result of the tannin and wood sugars.

Shiraz

This immensely popular dry red wine is rich and intense. With flavours of bell pepper, plum and red berry fruits like black currents and blackberries, this wine is suited to age for many months. Its peppery nose has notes of chocolate and spice.

Valpolicella

Distinguished by its ruby-red colour, its bouquet of ripe cherries is enhanced by a touch of vanilla. It combines both subtlety and complexity on the palate with its medium acidity and softer tannins that bring roundness and finesses as well as good structure. Overall it is a rich and velvety wine with a soft, gentle finish.

Vieux Chateau du Roi

This rich, hearty, robust Rhone red is full-bodied with a complex bouquet. It shows flavours of plum and wild berry on the plate, ending in a long full finish.

Zinfandel

Bright garnet robe with purple highlights. A delicate nose with ripe black cherries and wildberry undertones. This Zinfandel strikes a perfect balance on the palate, well structured with a long finish.
